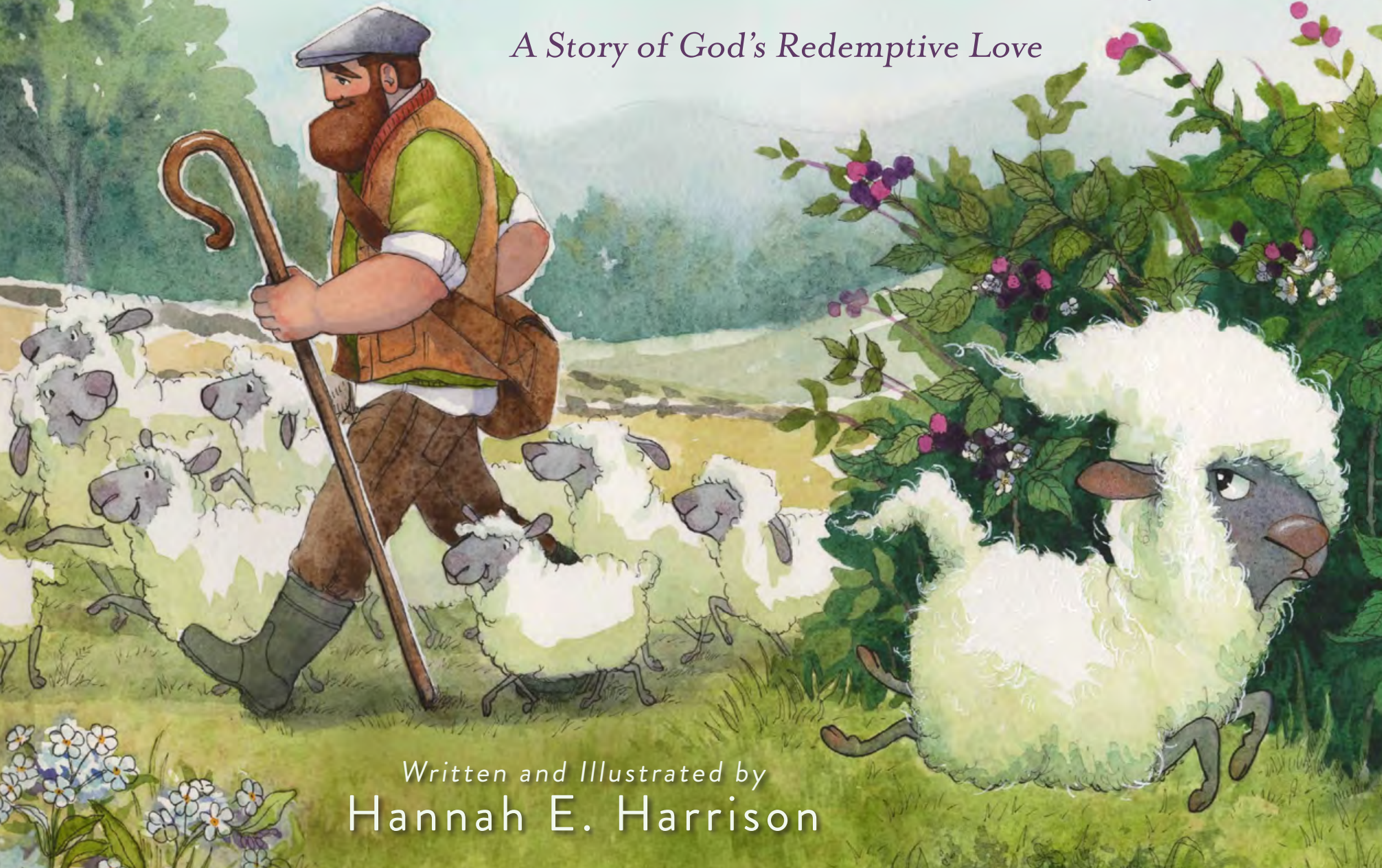

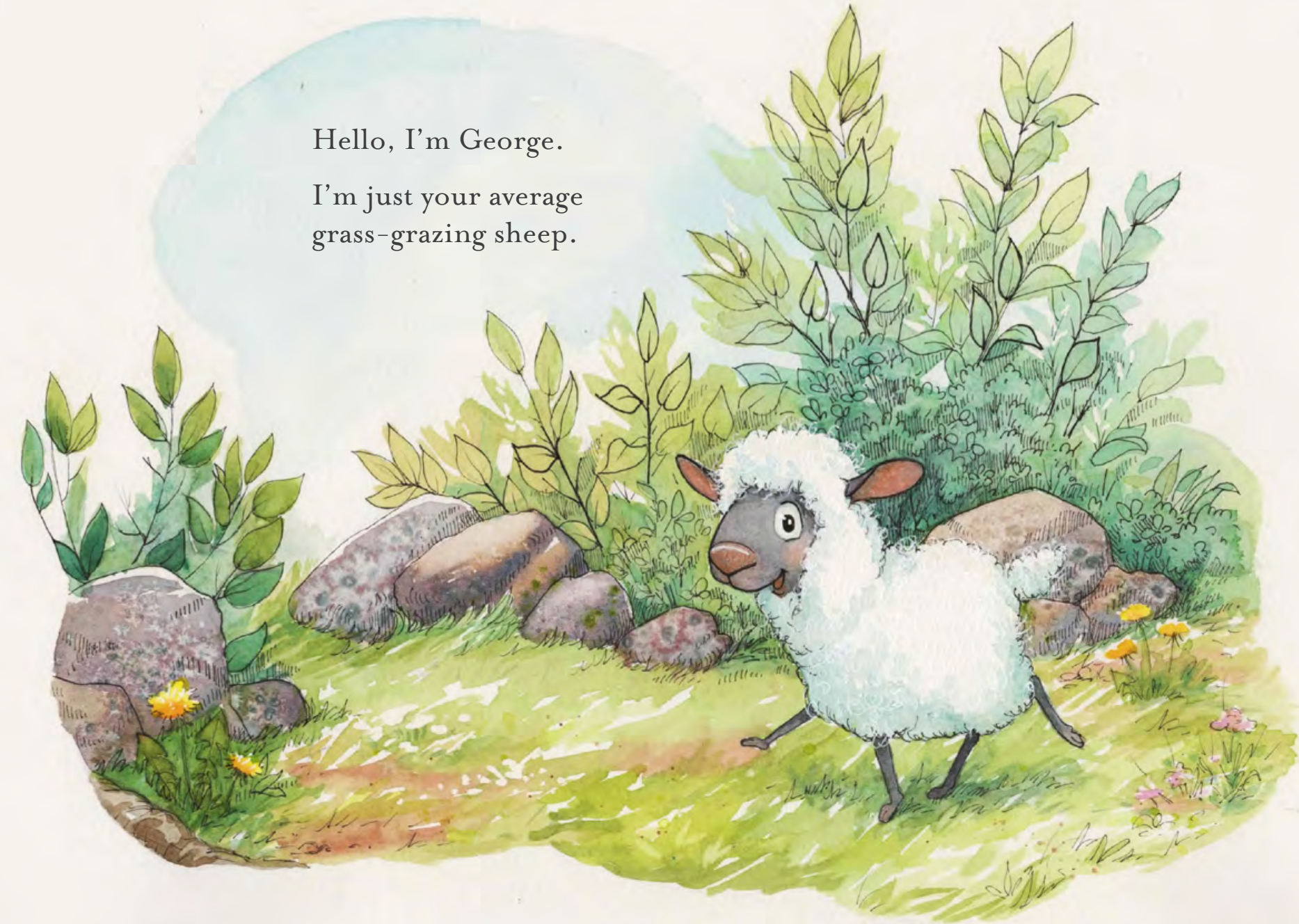

We all, like sheep, have gone astray . . .

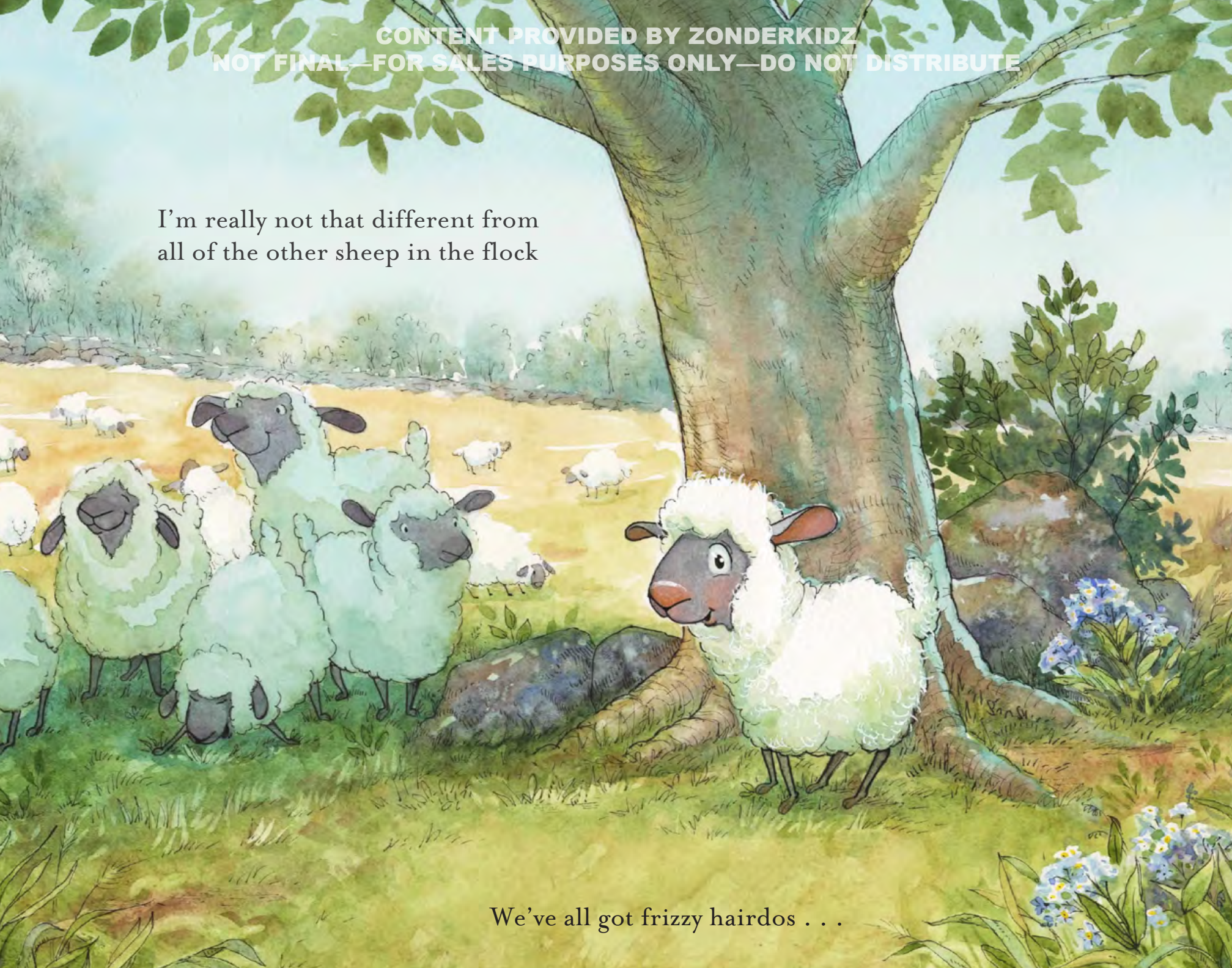

But there was this one time when the Shepherd wanted to give me a haircut. Only I liked my wool the way it was. In fact, I thought I looked pretty good!

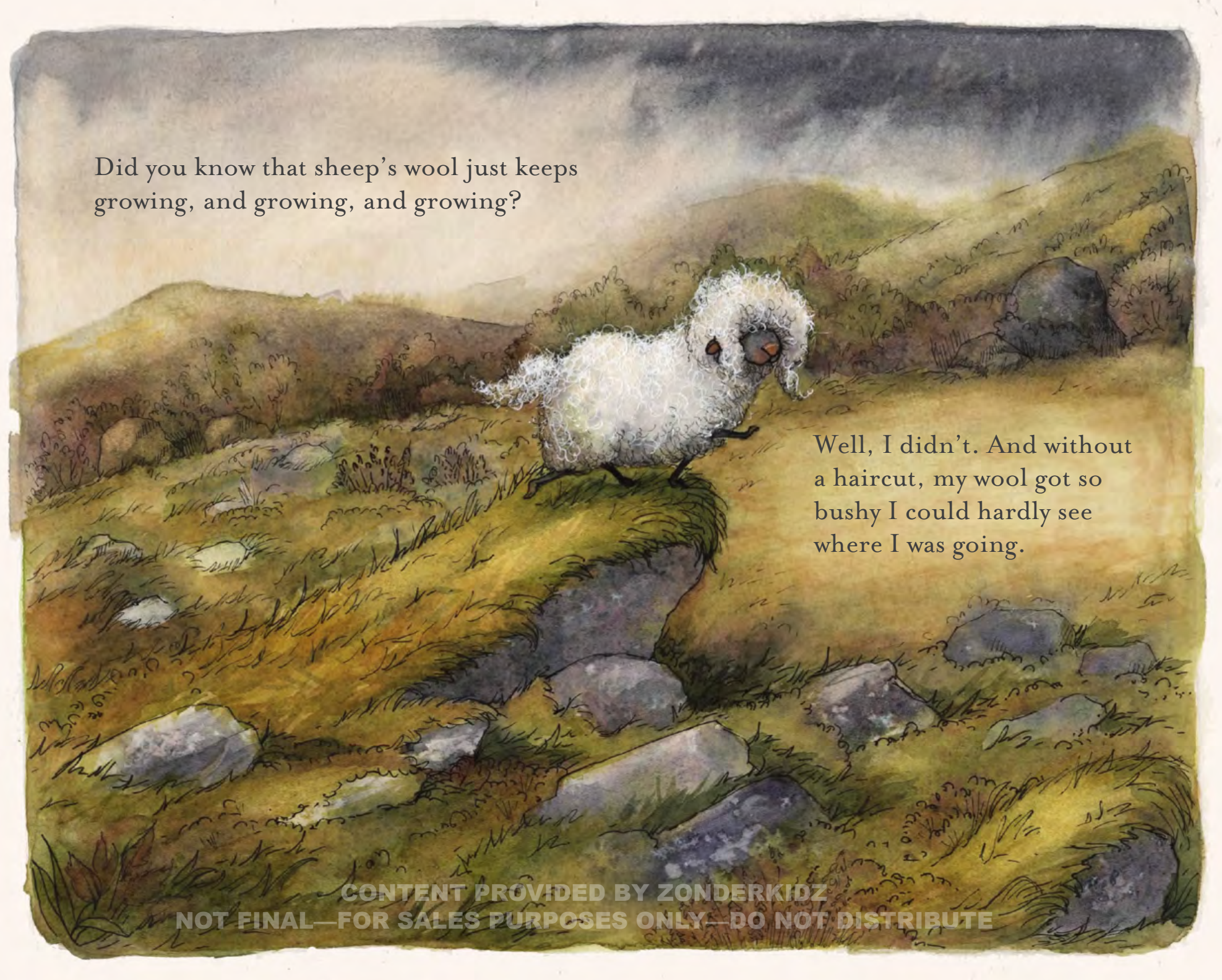


So I ran away.
