8. ***You find happiness.*** “Happy is he who keeps the law” (Proverbs 29:18).
9. ***You have peace.*** “Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; for the future of that man is peace” (Psalm 37:37).
10. ***You have a long life.*** “My son, do not forget my law, but let your heart keep my commands; for length of days and long life and peace they will add to you” (Proverbs 3:1-2).
