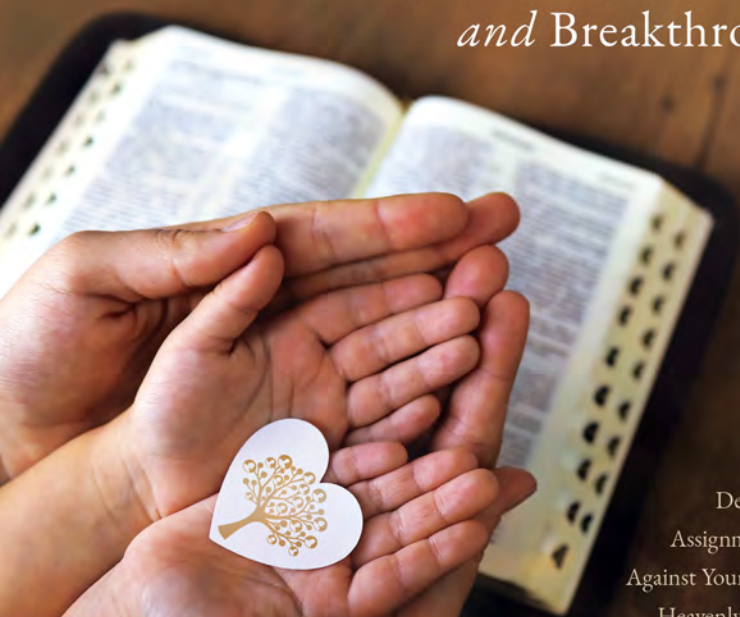

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PEACE IN OUR HOME

DECLARATION

TODAY we decree that our home is filled with God's unsurpassable peace. The atmosphere is saturated with tranquility and serenity. We rely on the Lord's peace, which provides a sense of assurance in our minds and emotions. We declare that we are relaxed and calm. We break the powers of agitation, mayhem, chaos, and disarray in the Name of Jesus! We cast out any evil spirit that would bring disorder to the atmosphere. We declare that those who dwell in our home contribute to peace and do not give place to anything that would create turmoil. We speak that every person who enters our home is enveloped in heavenly peace. We say our home is a place where guests feel the Lord's supernatural rest upon them, and it opens the way for miracles in their lives. We speak great peace upon our home, in the mighty Name of Jesus!

SCRIPTURE

Now the Lord of peace himself give you peace always by all means. The Lord be with you all (2 Thessalonians 3:16).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

Let's face it, life is busy and there are countless things that can disrupt the peace in our homes. Perhaps you work long hours and, as a result, responsibilities at home tend to fall behind, or maybe you have small children who need constant attention. In addition, there can be things like health issues and financial challenges that can rob our homes of peace. But the good news is the Lord is the giver of peace! He can extend a supernatural peace that can squelch the mayhem that would seek to invade your house. I want to encourage you to declare peace over your home. Along with that, work to create a peaceful home environment. Things like eliminating clutter, reducing excess noise, and increasing general organization can all contribute to improving peace. Remember, we do what we can both in the natural realm and the spiritual realm to walk in the peace the Lord wants us to experience. The key is not to allow life to rob the Lord's peace from your house!

WE WILL SERVE THE LORD

DECLARATION

TODAY we declare that all who live in our home serve the Lord. We prophesy that each member of this household honors God in word, action, and deed. We are a family who gives the Lord the place of supreme rule, and we choose to uphold His Word and commandments. His Name shall always be revered under our roof. We speak words of praise and esteem about the Lord. We speak that in this home the Lord is high and lifted up, and His presence fills every room! We say that no antichrist spirit is able to operate in this house. We break the power of any opposing spirit or influence, and we close the door to all things that dishonor our God. We decree that the banner written upon the doorposts of this house is, “As for me and my house, we serve the Lord!”

SCRIPTURE

And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord (Joshua 24:15).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

One of the most important things a family can do is decide that their home will be a place where God is honored. This means that anything that would dishonor the Lord is not allowed access to the premises; all that is said and done carries the Lord's honor upon it. Moses taught the children of Israel that they were to teach their children to praise and honor God in everything they did. This was not to be a one-time decision. It was something they acknowledged in an ongoing way. There is so much in our culture that dishonors God today and, over time, it can be easy to unintentionally allow things to creep into

our homes that are in opposition to the Lord. Regularly making the verbal declaration—that your house will be one that gives God the preeminence in everything—will ensure your home remains free of the things that would bring dishonor to Him!

TIME FOR TOGETHERNESS

DECLARATION

TODAY we declare that our home is filled with oneness, togetherness, unity, and fellowship. Our home is characterized by a closeness and affection between all who live and visit here. We love to be together, talk, interact, and communicate with one another. We are a family that enjoys fun activities without distraction or interruption. We say that nothing can disrupt our family time and the closeness we share in this home. We break the power of all evil spirits that would come to separate, divide, distract, or invade our togetherness, in Jesus' Name! We prophesy that we have our schedules, plans, and activities in order so that an atmosphere of unity thrives and we can spend time together without disruption or distraction. We say that we are a household of togetherness and we are a family of closeness!

SCRIPTURE

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! (Psalm 133:1)

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

If you are like many families, you already know the challenges that can arise to keep you from spending quality time with your loved ones. You also know there are countless things that can creep in to create separation until everyone is so busy doing their own thing that they're doing nothing together. Family togetherness is the quest of nearly every family that exists, and it's something to be fought for and protected. Make it a goal to develop quality family time, while simultaneously considering what you can eliminate that might disrupt family togetherness. Too often a sense of closeness isn't just built by what we do; it's also built by what we remove. For example, too many hours at work will eventually take its toll on family time. It's also important to consider that a sense of togetherness can be easily increased through simple, meaningful, and regular conversation.

Phone calls, kind notes, and thoughtful gestures all lead to feelings of closeness. Lastly, avoid speaking words of division or expressing continual feelings of frustration. Instead, declare togetherness and allow it to permeate the atmosphere of your home!

AN ORDERLY ENVIRONMENT

DECLARATION

TODAY we prophesy that we live lives of order. We say that we live in a home that is decent and orderly. We say that our household is run and operated in a tidy, organized, and constructed manner. We live in a clean and safe environment. We declare that no evil spirits of disorder, disarray, filth, or mayhem can operate here, in Jesus' Name! Our home is free of all hazards, pitfalls, risks, and peril. We do not allow our home to be in ill repair. We prophesy that we have the wisdom and insight to create functionality in every room of our home. We enjoy an inviting, pleasant atmosphere throughout our house and say it's a place where we love to spend our time. We speak that heaven's decorum is represented in our home and all who enter here see the excellence that characterizes our place of habitation.

SCRIPTURE

Let all things be done decently and in order
(1 Corinthians 14:40).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

While the context of the Scripture above is about the local church assembly, it's also a general truth which reveals that God expects the environments we inhabit to be characterized by order. Whether it be our place of business, our home, or our churches, God wants there to be visible order in all we do because we are His representatives. We should reflect the order of heaven because heaven is an orderly place. This isn't to say we need to be perfect and that each room in our house shouldn't have a single thing out of place. Let's face it, we live real lives and messes happen! However, we shouldn't be constantly surrounded by a cluttered mess. This way of living discredits us and isn't a good testimony to the Lord. When the Queen of Sheba came to visit Solomon, the Bible notes that she was not only impacted by the opulence of Solomon's house, but she was

particularly impacted by the excellence and order of how his kingdom functioned (see 1 Kings 10:1-5). Of course, we don't have to live opulent lives like King Solomon to create order; we can create an inviting environment in the humblest place of living. What's important is that God is a God of order, and we can't disregard the fact that this is part of His nature. We should strive for an environment of order in all we do. Speaking and decreeing order in your life is a great way to develop the consciousness to create it. And at the end of the day, there isn't a person on earth who doesn't enjoy clean and orderly surroundings!

GLORY IN THE ATMOSPHERE

DECLARATION

WE decree that an atmosphere of God's glory floods our home. We speak and say that the presence of the Lord is everywhere. We call for the cloud of God's *Shekinah* glory to invade every room and crevice of our house. May every person who enters here be affected by the glory of the Lord. Because of the atmosphere of glory, we receive the goodness of the Lord, even as Moses saw God's goodness when he encountered the glory. We take authority over any demonic interference that would squelch the atmosphere of glory. We prophesy that in the glory we are changed, healed, and delivered. We submit ourselves to whatever the Holy Spirit wants to accomplish. We avail ourselves of spending time in the Lord's presence, and we allow the glory to rest upon our lives. Lord, we thank You that Your glory permeates us and is welcome in our house. Like Moses, we ask to see Your glory and we want to experience it daily in our home!

SCRIPTURE

I beseech thee, shew me thy glory (Exodus 33:18).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

The encounter between God and Moses in Exodus 33 is undoubtedly one of the most impactful biblical encounters between God and a human being. It was an expression of a man who wanted to be entirely immersed in the awesome presence of Almighty God. Moses' yearning was so intense that he literally begged for the Lord to allow His glory to be visible. In other words, Moses wanted to see God with his eyes!

Today we are not much different than Moses in our desire to see the Lord. Yes, we want to see Him with our eyes, but we also want to experience Him in every aspect of our being. We express this desire by saying, "I want to experience the glory!" In that, we want our homes to be a place where the glory of the Lord is present and felt by those who live in and enter our home. We want our homes to be a place where people come and literally sense the Lord.

If you want to have the Lord's glory in the atmosphere of your house, then it needs to be cherished and protected. Be careful not to allow things that squelch the glory or interfere with it. Consider the things you read or watch on TV or electronic devices. Ensure that your actions do not hinder the presence of His glory. Then make the point to invite the Lord's glory to have its welcomed place around you on a regular basis. Ask the Lord for the atmosphere of glory to be in your home!

GOD'S GOODNESS REIGNS HERE!

DECLARATION

WE decree that we live under the umbrella of God's immeasurable goodness. His goodness reigns in our home. We live each day experiencing His goodness, grace, and mercy. We prophesy that His goodness shall pass before us as it did Moses, and we shall be placed upon the rock of a sure foundation. In our house, we declare that the Lord is good and His mercy endures forever. We do not focus on the negatives, disappointments, and setbacks. We break the power of any evil spirit that would come to cloud our minds and prevent us from seeing the good. We make the decision as a household to promote the good, see the good, and speak about the good acts of God in our lives. We prophesy that surely goodness and mercy shall follow us all the days of our life and that evil cannot track us! We speak that we shall experience good things from the Lord in the days ahead and it

will cause us to rejoice and shout for joy! May the goodness of the Lord always reign in our hearts, reign in our lives, and reign in our home, in Jesus' Name!

SCRIPTURE

And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the Lord before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy
(Exodus 33:19).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

One of the greatest things God wants His people to understand about His character is that He is good! Too often, religion teaches us to see God's judgment and wrath. While God does exhibit judgment simply because He is just, we must also know that God isn't recklessly raining judgment upon people. In fact, you often hear people question why so much evil in the world seems to go on unchecked and God seemingly doesn't do anything. Why

doesn't God just step in to stop it? Because He is a good God! He is giving people everywhere the opportunity to repent and turn to Him. This isn't to say evildoers will not eventually be judged; we all *do* reap what we sow (see Gal. 6:7). However, God wants to give people as much time as possible to turn away from evil. We see further revelation about this at the birth of Jesus, when the angels made the proclamation, "Peace on earth, goodwill toward men" (see Luke 2:14). The angels were announcing that because of Jesus, God's hand of wrath was being stayed until the appointed time.

The important thing is to see that God is good! He *wants* to extend goodness to humanity, and He wants to extend His goodness toward you! Begin each day expecting His goodness to surround you and know that this is what He is proclaiming upon you and your family!

UNITY AND AGREEMENT AMONG US

DECLARATION

TODAY we decree that unity and agreement reigns in our home. We prophesy that we work together in harmony in all we do. We say that the anointing of the Lord comes to bring us into one accord and that we work as a unified family under the governance of the Word of God. We agree with God's Word and therefore agree together on our plans, decisions, ideals, calling, and purpose. We agree on how to govern our family and manage our occupations. We agree on where to live, what to buy, when to move, and where to fellowship. We agree regarding all things that are relevant to life and godliness. We are unified in our stance that evil has no place in our lives. We are one, under the command of our Lord Jesus Christ. We break the power of all disunity, discord, and conflict, in the Name of Jesus! We speak unity, oneness, harmony, and peace. We humble ourselves under the Lord's

almighty hand and we submit ourselves to one another in the bond of peace. May a supernatural spirit of agreement reside upon us that causes us to build our lives as a strong family unit. We declare unity and agreement is among us!

SCRIPTURE

Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! (Psalm 133:1)

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

One of the most challenging things that a family or household can face is when its members are not unified in the key issues of life. When a married couple, or even families with older children still at home, find themselves going in multiple directions, it can wreak havoc. A good example is when one person feels a strong conviction about something that another doesn't share. One person believes the family should go down a certain path and the other one isn't convinced. In some cases, one person is serving God while their spouse or children are unbelieving. One

of the primary ways to build household agreement is by focusing on the areas where agreement already exists and build upon them. Learn to emphasize the things you do agree on. Too often as people, we allow ourselves to focus on the areas where we differ, and this only serves to magnify disunity. Sure, families or married couples may not agree on every point, but the key is to make a practice of agreement. Search for agreement and look for ways to defer to the other person or people in your home in a way that values their thoughts and ideas. Learn to listen and hear the heart of each person and then begin to speak and declare unity. Believe God that your plans and ideas will be yoked together in a heavenly way and that He will cause your entire household to be on an overall path of agreement and unity.

EFFECTIVE

COMMUNICATION ESTABLISHED

DECLARATION

WE decree that effective communication is established in our home. We prophesy that we are skilled communicators and we grow in our ability to converse and articulate our thoughts. We declare according to the Word of God that we are quick to hear, slow to speak, and slow to anger. We say that we are able to control our tongues and we only speak what is good and edifying to those who hear. We declare that we have the skill to hear the hearts and minds of others through what they say, and we don't jump to conclusions or misconstrue their words. We break the power of all manner of confusion, misunderstanding, and misjudgment. We declare that each member of our household feels accepted, understood, and appreciated for their thoughts and values. We say our minds are open to receive and absorb what others are communicating whether in thought, word, or deed.

We say that our home is a place where quality communication flows freely and fluently, in Jesus' mighty Name!

SCRIPTURE

Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man (Colossians 4:6).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

Every successful relationship needs effective communication. In fact, one of the reasons many people turn to professional counseling is communication problems. We must understand that communication isn't always verbal; it's also our actions, attitude, and behavior. In fact, commonly in the King James Version of the Bible we see the word *conversation* used (see Eph. 4:22; Phil. 1:27), which today we associate with verbal communication. However, the word actually means *behavior*. What we do and how we act are forms of conversation. A person who is a skilled communicator typically isn't the person doing all the

speaking. Skilled communicators spend more time listening and absorbing information so that when they do speak, they are filled with substance and viable information rather than assumptions. If we want our family relationships to be healthy, we must become good communicators. This comes more naturally for some than others, but we must make the point to develop in this capacity. Begin by declaring that effective communication prevails in your family. Then make the point to practice what good communicators do—listen, appreciate, and then pause before responding. Behave in a mannerly way that communicates positively to those you love. Every house can have effective communication established among every member of the family!

RICHES IN OUR HOUSE

DECLARATION

WE decree that the riches and the provision of the Lord fills our house. We say that we will never lack any form of wealth to meet our physical and material needs. We are confident in the covenant promise that wealth and riches shall be in the house of the righteous and there is no lack to those who love the Lord. We prophesy increase and overflow. We declare that we always have more than enough so that we can be a blessing to others and to the Kingdom of God. We give of our wealth and, therefore, we are confident that the Lord will give back to us through the hands of people according to Luke 6:38. We decree that everything that is in our heart to accomplish financially under the Lord's direction, we are able to accomplish. We break the power of lack and decrease and prophesy that no spirit of decay or corruption can come to rob our wealth because we have

treasure stored in heaven! We stand in the confidence that our house experiences abundance today, and every day throughout the years to come, in Jesus' Name! Wealth and riches are in our house!

SCRIPTURE

Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever (Psalm 112:3).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

I once heard a man say, “There are few pressures in life that compare to financial pressure.” To a great extent, that is true. Money can have a tremendous effect on how people think and behave. It is often the source of fear and anxiety, particularly when a household or business is struggling to make ends meet. It’s hard not to get one’s eyes on the circumstances when the bills keep piling up. But this is *not* the will of God for His people! Financial stress and lack are not of God—they come from the enemy! We have a covenant promise that wealth and riches shall be in the house of the

righteous. Know without any shadow of doubt that this is God's will for you and your family. There are countless scriptures that remind us of not only God's provision, but His willingness to make that provision abundant. Walking in this promise comes by believing it with unshakable faith. First, make sure you are following the biblical parameters and requirements for handling your money. Tithe and give offerings as the Word of God teaches. Tithing, in and of itself, is an expression of your confidence in the Lord's provision. Second, practice good money-handling skills and know what the Bible says about mishandling of money. Then finally, speak and declare the promises of provision instead of speaking lack! All of the above can set you in a place to receive God's promise of wealth and riches miraculously resting over your house!

AN ATMOSPHERE FOR MIRACLES

DECLARATION

WE decree that our home is an atmosphere where miracles operate and manifest regularly. We declare that we receive divine experiences and supernatural encounters from heaven. We receive manifestations that turn impossible situations around and bring blessing and surprises. People get healed in our home and receive instantaneous miracles. We declare the manifestation of miracles, signs, and wonders flows freely. We say that signs follow the Word of God that is spoken and preached in our home. We invite the supernatural presence of the Lord to take up residence here. We break the power of all hindrances, unbelief, and religious spirits that would discount miracles, and we prophesy that our minds are open and receptive to the supernatural move of God. We are a family who creates the atmosphere of miracles in our home, in Jesus' Name!

SCRIPTURE

And the disciples went everywhere and preached, and the Lord worked through them, confirming what they said by many miraculous signs (Mark 16:20 NLT).

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

Many believers do not fully understand the miraculous side of God, particularly when it comes to receiving miracles in their own lives. People often do not progress beyond the realm of guessing what God will do about their situation, or if and when they will experience the miracle they're desiring. The age-old question of why some people receive a miracle and others do not remains difficult to answer because not all situations are exactly the same. However, we *do* know this: We *can* create an environment that sets the atmosphere for miracles. We see this in the ministry of Jesus. People who received miracles from Him were in a place of faith for such; they were anticipating that they would receive (see Matt. 8:13; Mark 5:34; 9:23). On the flip side, when Jesus came to Nazareth, He was unable

to do any mighty works because of their unbelief (see Mark 6:5). They resisted and analyzed Jesus' miracle-working power and, as a result, they did not receive. We must be people who create an atmosphere that is receptive to God's miracle-working power. We do so by believing for it, not by analyzing it logically and ultimately rejecting it, like the people of Nazareth. Instead, talk about miracles in your home. When you pray, tell the Lord how much you believe in His miracle power. Build your faith on the Word of God that reveals how willing He is to exercise His miraculous nature on your behalf. Declare that your home is filled with miracles, and always speak accordingly. Lastly, avoid unbelief and speaking negatively when circumstances seem adverse and it doesn't appear that God will step in. Your home *is* a place for miracles!
