The Story of Noah from Genesis 6–9

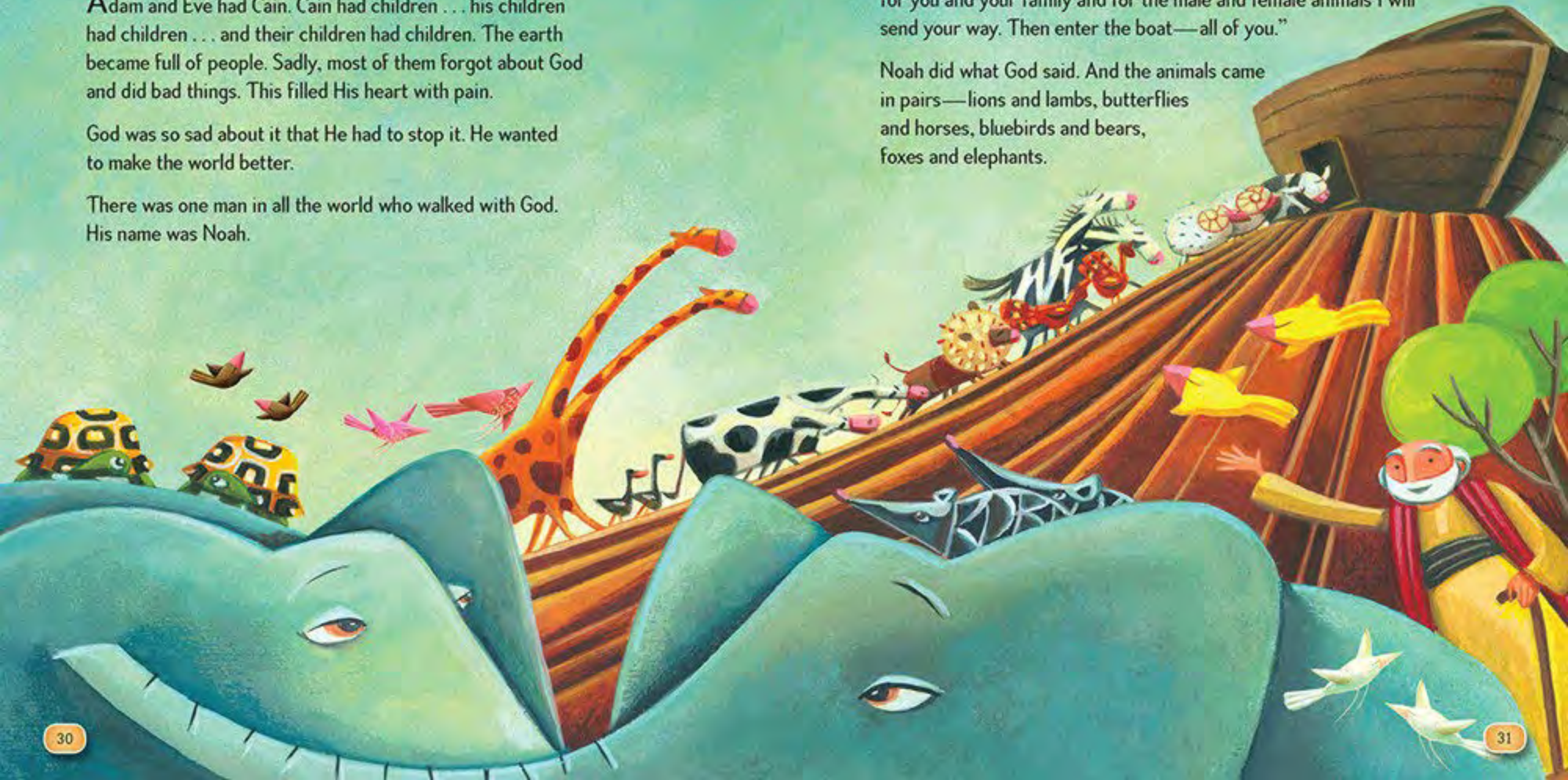
