and empty, and darkness

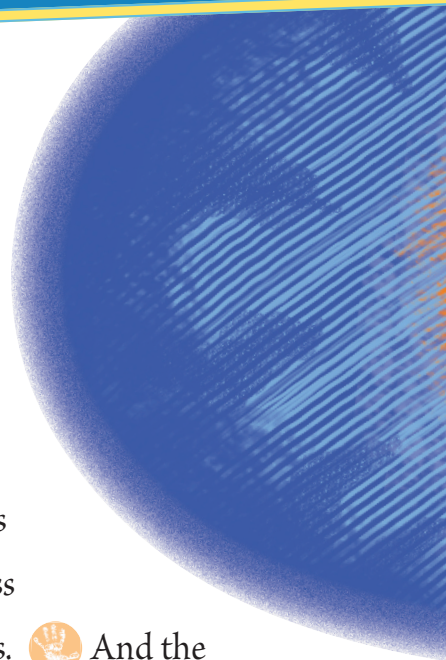
covered the deep waters.  And the

darkness. 

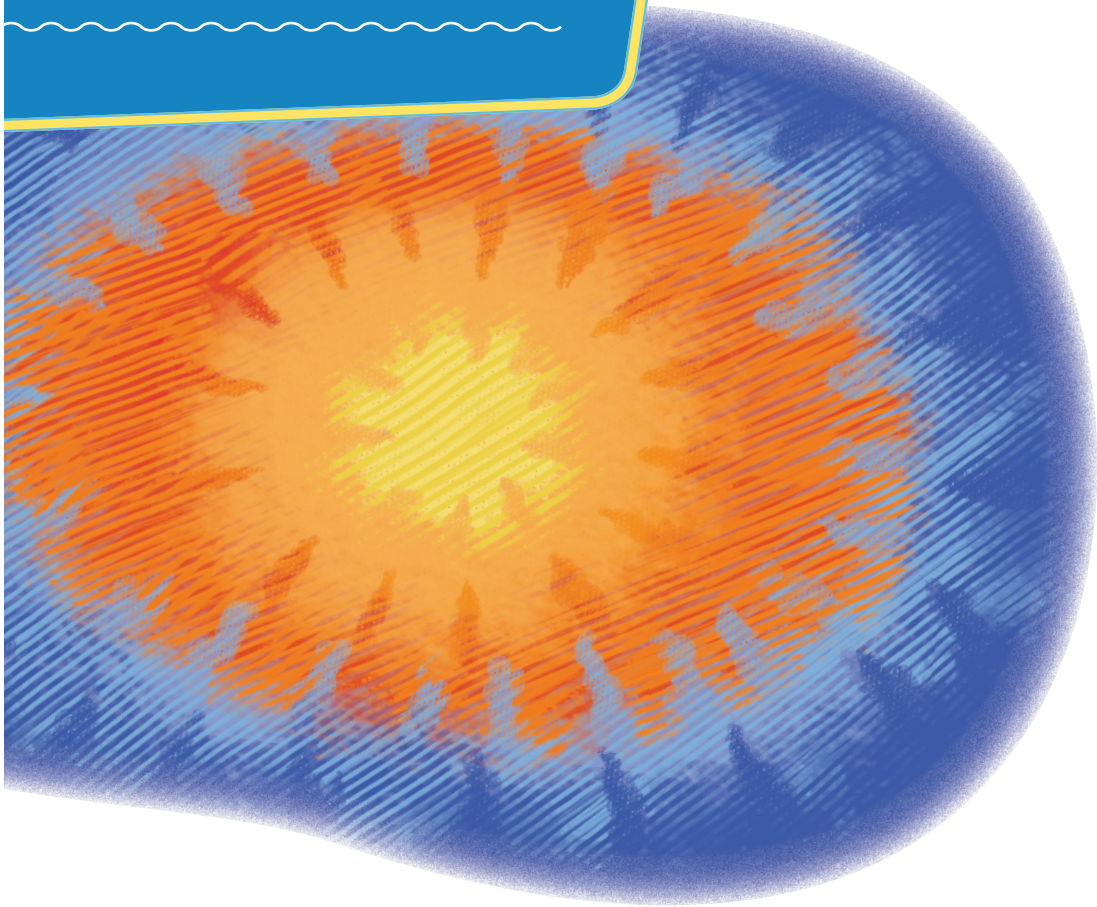

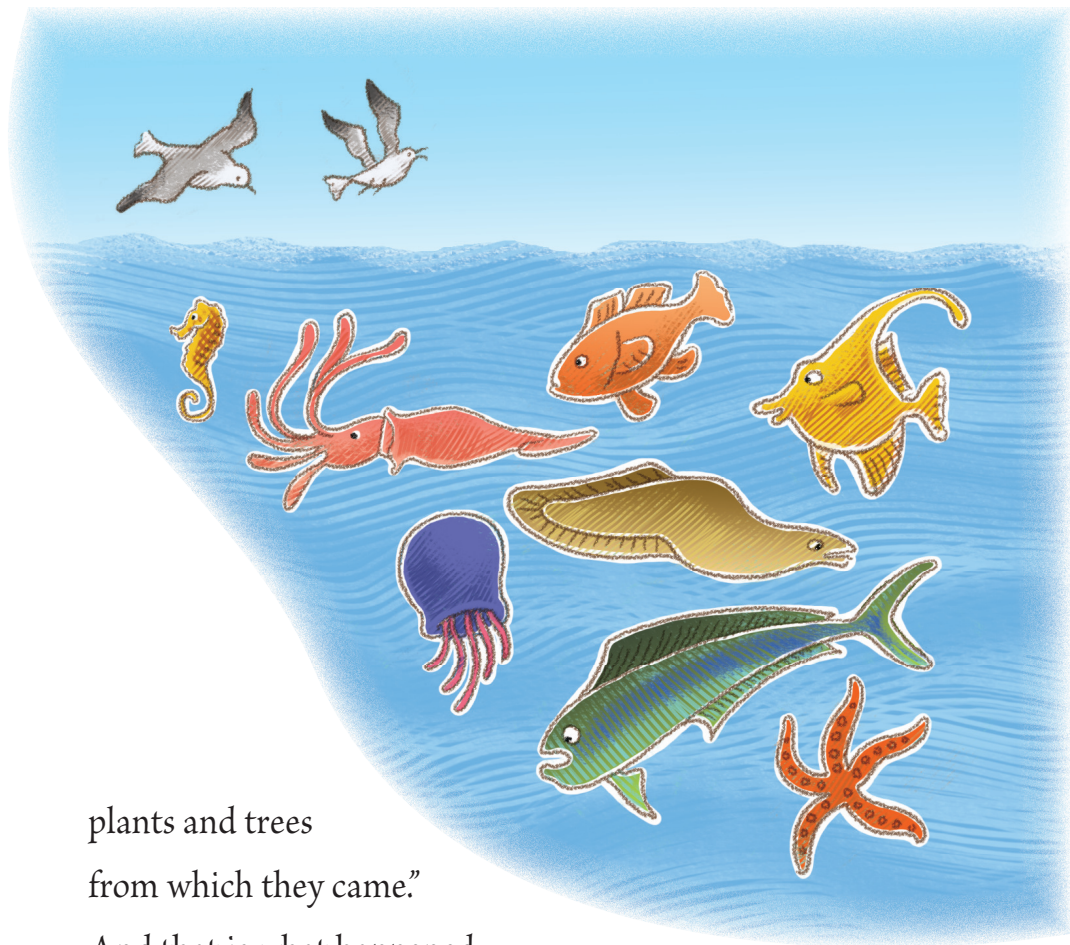

¹⁶God made two great lights—the larger one to govern the day, and the smaller one to govern the night. He also made the stars. 🖐️

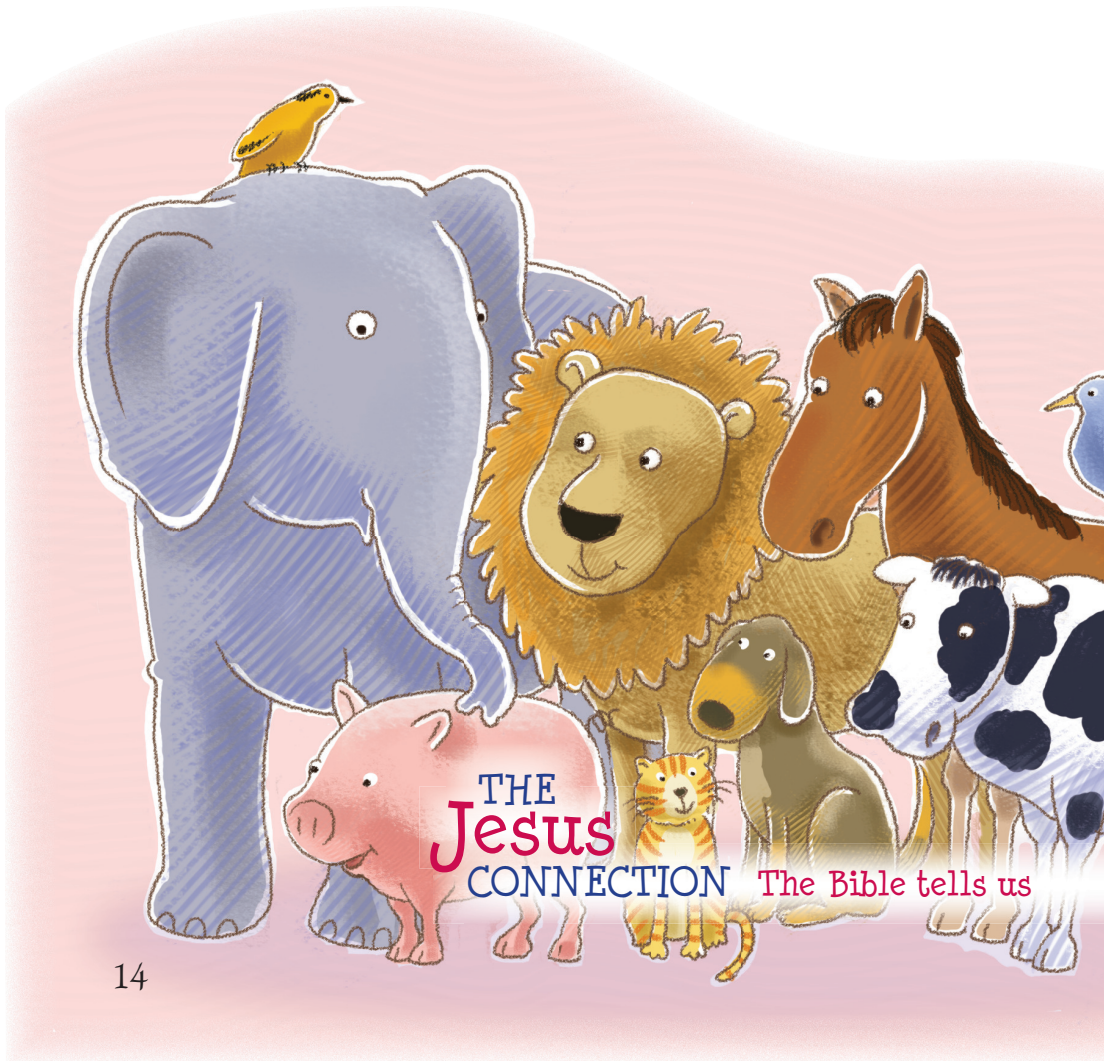
